## **Make it a New Year's Resolution – Register for a Free On-Line Child ID from the Laura Recovery Center**

The Laura Recovery Center (LRC) is pleased to announce the immediate availability of its On-Line Child ID, a free, easy to use, on-line tool to help you gather information about your child that could be crucial should they ever become missing.

The LRC On-Line Child ID provides a private and secure location on the Internet to keep your information, a means to download it to your own computer or memory device such as a USB flash drive, and the option to share your information immediately with law enforcement and others.

If your child should disappear, for whatever reason, could you remember important details about them such as their height, eye color, or scars and birthmarks; the names of their friends and how to contact them; the names of the trusted adults in your child's life such as scout leaders and clergy; their medicines and other special needs; and where their dental and medical records are stored? Could you quickly locate and share pictures of your child that would help law enforcement and volunteers search for them?

If your child should ever be missing, you will need all of this information and more, and you will need to locate it immediately.

The Laura Recovery Center is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization, that was founded in Laura Smither's memory.
