On January 20, 2008 Brianna Denison disappeared from 1395 Mackay Court in Reno, Nevada. The Reno Police Department has confirmed that the suspect responsible for a sexual assault and kidnapping that occurred on December 16, 2007, is responsible for Brianna's disappearance.

She is 5'00", 98 lbs., with long dark brown hair, blue eyes, nose pierced on right side, and scar on left knee. Brianna was last seen wearing a white tank top with pink angel wings, rhinestones & "Bindi" on the back and pink sweat pants.

Searching was delayed by the snow and cold but got underway the following Tuesday. The community of Reno is fully supporting the search for Brianna with large numbers of volunteers each day and much needed supplies. The Reno police have worked closely with the community search effort, and valuable information has been exchanged between the two organizations. Local volunteers are now trained and handling all aspects of the search.

As of this writing, the search continues for Brianna.
